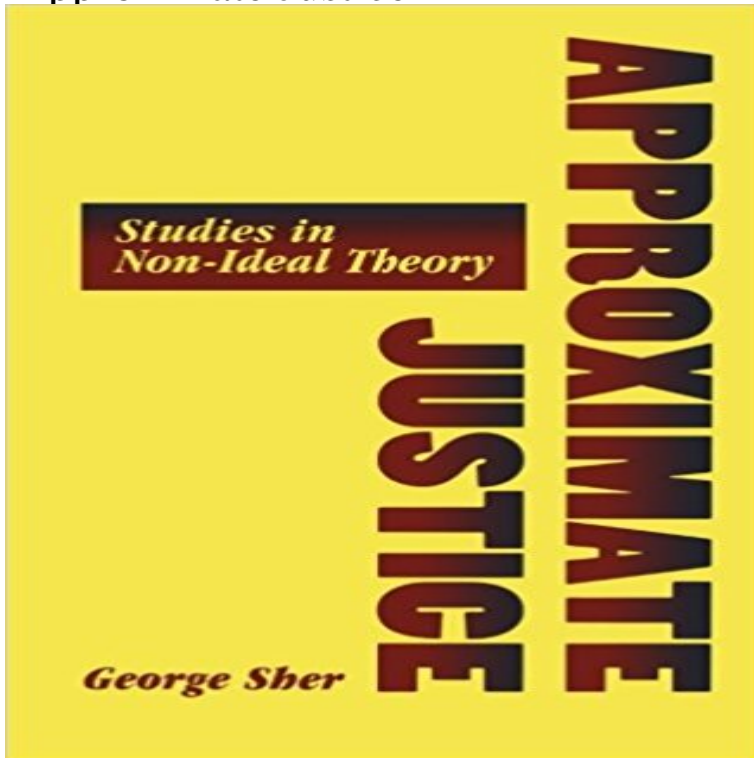


Approximate Justice
