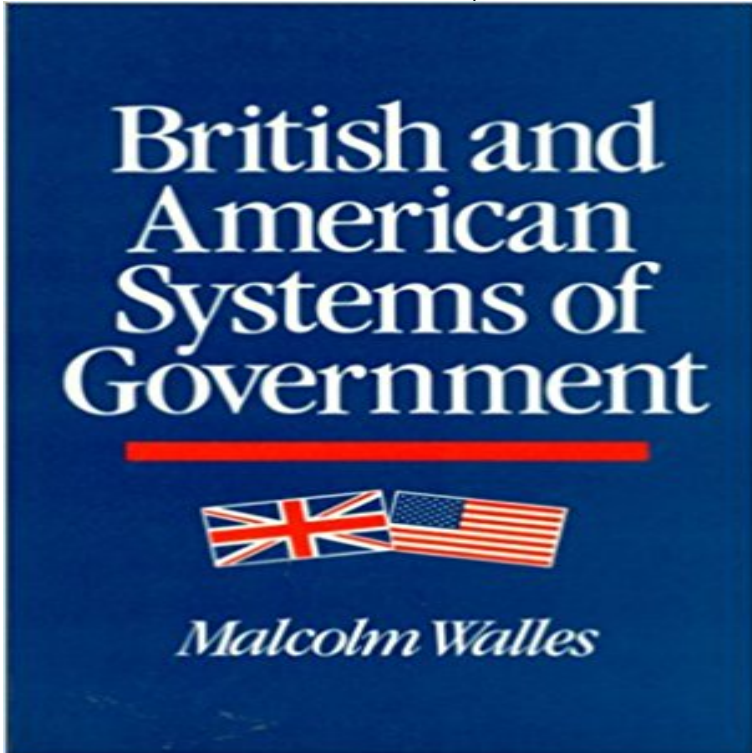


British and American Systems of Government
