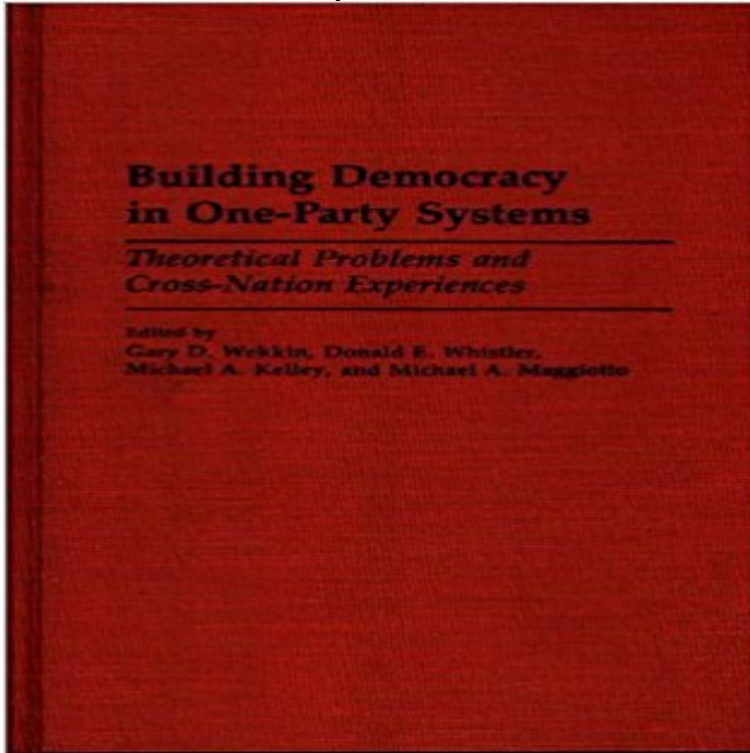


Building Democracy in One-Party Systems: Theoretical Problems and Cross-Nation Experiences
