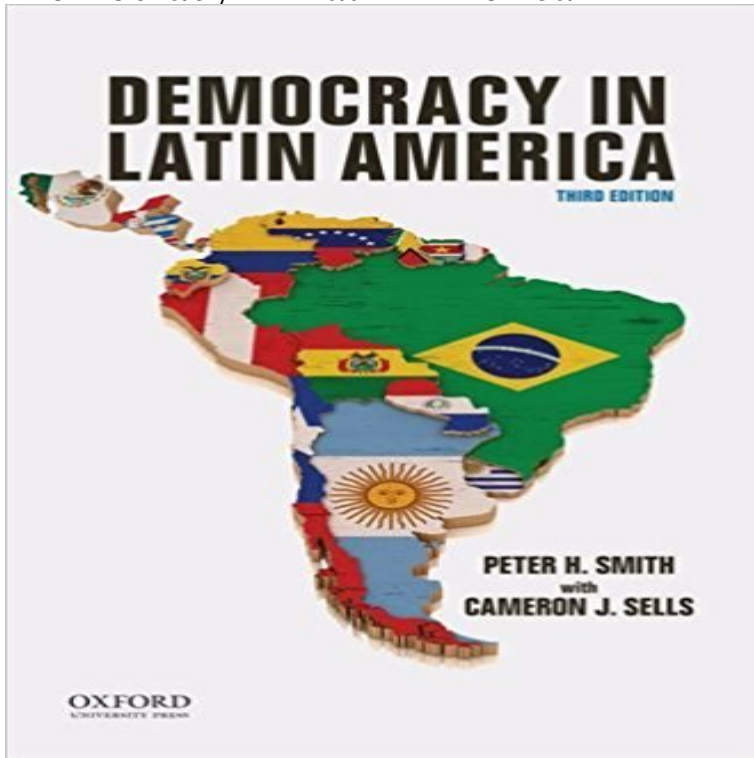


Democracy in Latin America
